



## **July 12, 2016 Meeting Notes**

Today, Tuesday July 12, 2016, Bob White and Dan Macone met with Bryce Bennett, NJ licensed landscape architect. We toured three beach accesses, Harding Avenue., narrow with a lot of vegetation, Pershing Avenue, some vegetation and Jacqueline Avenue, completely barren. The following are the notes from the meeting.

The meeting with Bryce Bennett was very informative. He discussed many native plants that can be used. The key is now to establish the area that LBT will let us plant. Bryce also confirmed October and April are best times to plant; when there are no leaves on plants. Cellulose Gel- PHC Plant Saver must be used with soil. The plant hole size should be 3 times the pot size, a 5-inch pot hole should be 15 inches in diameter. Fertilizer types need to be specified. Bryce seemed to think that the type plants that he will recommend should not be a problem to source for planting this fall.

After Dan's meeting with Angela Anderson on Wednesday, it is hoped that we can provide a plot plan to Bryce Bennett for planting several specific beach entrances.
