Role on Current Board

As Recording Secretary, Bob is responsible for writing the minutes for each meeting of the Board of Trustees as well as all meetings of the full HTA Membership. These minutes are then posted on the HTA website. He also serves as Chairman of the Nominating Committee and is a member of the By-Laws Committee and the Dune Planting Committee, which he initiated.
